<u>6</u> Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things.

This means that we that believe God are taught of God as we read and STUDY the scriptures or the Word of God.

AND we are to COMMUNICATE, firstly to God the teacher, secondly to those around us.

Communicate to God means to **SHARE** your inner most secrets unto the Lord, your desires your praise, your plans and goals and your love for him.

Communicate to others means: (to SHARE the things that the Holy Spirit has taught you, the plan of salvation through Christ Jesus, his blood that was shed For Us.)
The TRUE things we have seen, the things we have heard and the things we know in our heart. Acts 4:20

He does not teach us things to be suppressed or watered down as to many preachers and members of the Body of Christ (church) do today in fear of not being politically correct and someone may be offended. (political correctness is of the devil)

As long as we are not judging the individual but sharing the word of God as recorded in Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. The word of God will either cut the heart – thus bringing anger and hatred, (Acts 5:33 When they heard that, they were cut to the heart, and took counsel to slay

them. Acts 7:54 When they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth.) or it will prick them in the heart thus bringing repentance.

Acts 2:37 Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

OR IT WILL FALL ON DEAF EARS!!

Zechariah 7:11 But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear.

So you see, it is not you that is judging or convicting the people BUT the word of the Living God. He knows the inner most secrets of each individual.

- <u>7</u> Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
- 8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. If you sow a watered down testimony then you will gather people that want a watered down Gospel. If you want to build a fellowship of numbers, this is the way to quickly build a big local church. Sow the teachings that produce the love or lust of money, that God is a God of love and would never send anyone to hell and will give3 you your hearts desire as far as your lusts are concerned, you will get numbers but not sincere people.

 1John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the

flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

BUT if you sow the truth under the anointing of the Holy Spirit, you will build a solid church with signs and wonders following. A fellowship where there are miracles and healing's that are common place. There will be an increase in those that repent of their sins and except Jesus as Lord and Savior.

If you sow your excitement to the gospel you WILL reap excitement in your flock. A positive and a happy countenance will spread.

The flesh is anything sensual to ones own self.

Numbers 15:39 And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring:

Sowing to the spirit is multiple things: Faith, Prayer, Study, Tithing, Love, Giving and Sharing and many more.

Matthew 6:8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: (religious)

for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.
