#150 The Mouth

What we confess with are mouth is what will happen - example: "it's only going to get worse": IT WILL!!!

Romans 10:10* For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

(Not only do we confess our belief in salvation BUT also the things we have ask God for. It is called Faith or Trust in Gods word)

Matthew 15:18 But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man.

Matthew 15:11 Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man. If one is full of doubt and FEAR, then you are doing exactly what Satan wants.

2Timothy 1:7* For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

1John 4:18* There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

Hebrews 13:6* So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

Why do Christians have no problem believing that Jesus went to the Cross for our sins BUT do not believe the rest he went to the Cross for, nor what is written in his word. The minute you just believe with your natural senses Taste, Smell, Hear, Feel and See. It is like saying: Jesus I only believe PART of what you did and it is a slap in his face. This borders very close to a double minded person.

<u>James 1:6-8</u> But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of

the Lord.

A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.

<u>Matthew 12:34</u>* O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh

God set the example for us, creation was all done by the spoken word. Throughout the scriptures things happened as HE spoke.

<u>Luke 1:70*</u> As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:

Trust & Faith are the same

trust - **A** firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability, or strength of someone or something : relations have to be built on trust

faith - A complete trust or confidence in someone or something:

Jude 20* But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

1John 5:4* For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

James 5:15* And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Hebrew 11:30* By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days.

Hebrews 11:31* By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace. You see, they didn't see the result first, they

believed first and acted upon their faith.

Hebrews 11:6* But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

There are multitudes of Christians that say: "I will not lie": I still have pain, I don't see any difference, the Dr says and so on. In other words they are ruled by the Carnal nature their natural senses, instead of the Spirit senses.

God SAYS that whatsoever YOU ask in his name, he will do it. SO you say: "I have ask God and he cannot lie he will intervene and no matter the feelings or outcome I will trust him. Now this is NO LIE, it is faith in God.

Hebrew 11:1* Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

<u>NASB</u> Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

Hebrews 10:38* Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

2Corinthians 5:7* (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

Those that walk by sight or natural senses are in danger of Matthew 7:21* Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
