## *Hades or Sheol V/S Hell*

Below is the Hebrew and Greek words that the KJV has translated into HELL, they are ALL CORRECT.

Hebrew –lwav = Hades, Sheol, Depth, Grave

Greek –sh@'owl sheh-ole' or grave, hell, pit, Hades

**sheol**, underworld, grave, hell, pit, the underworld,  
the #1 designation for the abode of the ungodly dead,  
centre of the earth, lower parts of the earth,  
Heart of the earth, wicked sent there for eternity, Hades  
**HELL** was never originally created for man it was created for  
the devil and his angels.

Jude 6\* And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left  
their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains  
under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

2Peter 2:4\* For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but  
cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of  
darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

Sheol was the place where paradise and Hades was before  
Christ

Paradise after Jesus's resurrection was then incorporated into  
Hell/Sheol to expand their growing numbers. (an old saying, is that  
every time a volcano erupts, it is to expand the borders of Hell)

When mankind sinned and died, they were sent to Hades or  
Sheol.

The ungodly into where the wicked dead were sent (Hades), and  
the God fearing were sent to Paradise also known as Abrahams  
Bosom.

Matthew 12:40\* For as Jonas was three days and three  
nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three  
days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Psalms 16:10\* For thou wilt not leave my soul in  
hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One (Jesus) to see  
corruption NASB For Thou wilt not abandon my soul to Sheol;

*Neither wilt Thou allow Thy Holy One to undergo decay.*

**Psalms 18: 5-11\* The sorrows of hell compassed me about: the snares of death prevented me.**

**NASB The cords of Sheol surrounded me; The snares of death confronted me**

**6\* In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even into his ears.**

**7\* Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth.**

**NASB Then the earth shook and quaked; And the foundations of the mountains were trembling And were shaken, because He was angry.**

**8\* There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it.**

**9\* He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness was under his feet.**

**NASB He bowed the heavens also, and came down With thick darkness under His feet.**

**10\* And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.**

**11\* He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him were dark waters and thick clouds of the skies.**

In between the crucifixion and the resurrection, Jesus went into the heart of the earth for three days and three nights. **Psalms 16:9-10 and Acts 2:25-32 show that this was actually hell that Jesus descended into.**

Sheol was divided into two parts, one part being a place of torment (**Luke 16:19-25**) and the other a place of blessing with a great gulf between the two.

**Luke 16:26 And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.**

Jesus led the spirits of the godly dead out of Paradise or

Abrahams bosom at His resurrection,

**Psalms 68:18** Thou hast ascended on high, **thou hast led captivity captive**: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell among them.

**Ephesians 4:8-9\*** Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men. (Now that he ascended, what is it but that **he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth.** (preached to those in Paradise)

leaving only the wicked dead in this place of torment, which we call hell. At the last judgment, death and hell will deliver up the dead that are in them, and then they will be cast into a lake of fire where they will be tormented forever.

**Revelation 20:12-14** And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. **And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.**
