This does not mean your Carnal Desires, Ex: Money, New car, New house, New spouse, New trinkets etc. That don't mean you can't pray for a new house or car, IF YOU NEED ONE!!! But not carnal things

Ungodly Desires

<u>James 4:2</u>* Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not.

God placed desires

<u>Psalms 37:4</u> Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

When you get born again, God places HIS desires in your heart. The desires usually consist of reading and studying his word, No longer desiring to do the sinful things you did before and so on. This is true conversion. We can not listen to these new desires and thus continue to fulfill the lusts of the flesh, OR we can obey these new desires and become a new creature in Christ Jesus.

<u>2Corinthians 5:17</u>* Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new

<u>Deuteronomy 11:18</u> Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. How to tell if your desires are God given, first:

Matthew 11:28* Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. (Salvation)

<u>Matthew 6:33</u>* But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. (read or study the bible)

Hebrews 10:15-16 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days,

saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; If you have inner peace, it is quite probable it is of God.

Godly desire

Mark 11:24* Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

1Peter 2:2* As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby
