## Why New Doctrines after all these years

The Lord forewarned us that this would happen, especially in the latter days. Below are just a few scriptures that give us warning.

Colossians 2:8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

1 Timothy 1:7 Desiring to be teachers of the law; understanding neither what they say, nor whereof they affirm.

1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

Ephesians 4:14-15 That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:

King James had the word of God taken from the original scripts as the Lord brought it to the scholars that the king had commissioned to do the task.

It is so close, that when they discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls, there was no discrepancy. Even tho there are some denominations that do say: the scriptures are only written by man and they make mistakes. These same denominations turn around and say that scripture interprets scripture. *WHAT IS IT?* It can't be both. The scripture says:

2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

Who are you going to believe, Gods word or man. The scripture says:

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

1 Corinthians 10-16 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man. For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

Man has tried to understand the things of God through his own intellect and this is why they have tried retranslating the bible so they can understand and they still do not understand. They had a few different translations when King James gave his decree, but they were also instructed not to use them.

In the last fifty years, we have gotten more translations than you can shake a stick at. The one that is used by most churches now is the NIV:

Now I'm not trying to be picky but, there are so many discrepancies between these new versions and the KJV. The New Age Religions and translations have enough of a measure of truth in them that those who are after a superficial Christianity are drawn in hook line and sinker.
