

#291 *Are You Weak*

Mark 16:15-16 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

All the world is YOUR world, wherever YOU GO.

The other KEY word, IS BELIEVETH NOT shall be damned.

He that believeth is referring to those that even though they do not totally understand all the word of God, they infinitely believe it.

He that believeth NOT, refers to ALL those that say; miracles ceased when the 12 Apostles died, or God CAN still do miracles but not through man, or Tongues is nothing but a learned language. OR man cannot command Satan to do anything, you have to ask him. TO THIS I SAY BUNK.

What does the scripture say?:

Colossians 2:15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, (devil) he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Mark 1:8 I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

Acts 10:46 For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God.

Again, I say unto you the unbelieving refuse to take this literally. ARE YOU the 50% that has extra oil in their lamps, OR ARE YOU the 50% that make excuses for your unbelief, and thus have NO EXTRA oil. **Matthew 25:1 - 12**

Why is it so important to believe the baptism of the Holy Spirit as a separate occurrence from receiving salvation? FIRST OF ALL the Holy Spirit lives within you upon receiving Christ's atonement, the disciples believed Jesus was the son of God. Jesus himself, after his resurrection appeared to his disciples behind closed doors. **John 20.:19-22**

John 20:22 And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

NOW THIS REFERS TO the scriptures in **1Co 6:19**,

In other words this is talking about the Holy Spirit being WITHIN YOU

1Co 2:16 , **1Jo 2:27** and more.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit refers to the spirit that comes UPON YOU and you RECEIVE POWER to carry out the directions the Lord sets out in his word.

Jesus did not start his earthly ministry until AFTER the Holy Spirit descended and stayed upon him.

Luke 3:22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

John 1:32 And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

Every recording of the Holy Spirit interacting with man, in the old testament, is recorded as the Spirit came upon him and they prophesied or whatever.

We are to put ON the whole armor of God. **Eph 6:11-19**

Verses 18&19 speak about praying in the spirit and an utterance.

This is not thinking in your mind as so many denominations teach today, but rather with your mouth. The Holy Spirit (praying in tongues) makes intercession for you.

Ro 8:26 Ro 8:27

1Corinthians 14:22 Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not

Tongues is for your edification and building yourself up in the Spirit.

If you approach the baptism of the Holy Spirit with speaking in tongues in your natural mind, YOUR DEAD BEFORE YOU START

Romans 8:6 -9 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

WHY are so many denominations weak in the Spiritual things of God? Because they don't believe in the outward sign of the power of God, TONGUES. He don't make you a better Christian, but he DOES make you better equipped.

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
