

295 *Choose Not - To Be Left Behind*

**Warning: all scripture is King James Version, using other versions will probably change the meaning.**

**2Peter 3:9** The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

We have not been under the wrath and judgement of God, since Jesus took all his wrath at Calvary. When Jesus takes his church out of this world (We call the RAPTURE of the church). He comes in the Air not to earth.

**1Thessalonians 4:16\18** For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

**Revelation 3:10** Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

**Revelation 6:17** For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? Then the father (for the next seven years) is going to pour out his wrath and judgement upon the ungodly that are left here on earth. Satan will have virtually free reign and his wrath is mainly directed at Israel.

Remember, all the church, Spirit filled Christians (Jew and Gentiles) have been Raptured out of this world and there are none left to bind Satan and hold him back from moving all out against Israel. The church age is over and it will revert back to God and his chosen people Israel.

**(Rev 7:4\8) (Rev 11:3)**

This is when God is going to seal 144,000 Israelites to preach the gospel, along with the two witnesses.

There will be a revival, like you have never seen before, but they will have to pay with their life and be BEHEADED.

The Five Wise had extra oil and refilled their lamps, the five foolish had nothing extra and so their lamps went out.

The question is, WHAT IS the extra oil?

You probably will have multiple bible scholars give multiple answers. What does the bible say?

**Ephesians 2:8** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

The KEY word, is THROUGH FAITH

**1John 5:10** He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.

Now as Jesus said in Matthew, SEEK YE FIRST, if you put God first, and I do mean first, you will have no problem believing his word and not your own interpretation. If we don't understand something, go to Jesus first and not your denomination nor a mans commentary. Don't get me wrong, God will confirm his word through any means he chooses.

**Matthew 6:33** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

One thing very few people realize is that the Rapture is a prize for the church, it is not a mandate.

**Heb 12:1, 1Co 9:24, Php 3:14, 1Co 9:26 ,**

If you missed the rapture by not putting Christ First, What makes you think you'll refuse the mark of the beast, the peer pressure will be multiple times stronger than now.
