

Binding & loosing Spirits

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and **greater works than these shall he do**; because I go unto my Father.

Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently **give me more than twelve legions of angels?**

He could of but then he chose to pay the price for our redemption.

We can call upon angels to help us and others in a victorious walk with the Lord.

NOTE: Not command individual angels by names, but the ministering angels.

Hebrews 1:14 **Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?**

Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the *keys* of the kingdom of heaven: and **whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.** (All afflictions are from the enemy thus we bind the evil spirits and cast them out and then you have to loose something to fill the gap or to help the individual) ([Matthew 12:43-45](#))

THE KEY HERE IS - whatsoever **YOU** shall bind or loose. **NOT** please God, you loose, in other words he has given us the authority through Jesus and his shed blood. (Luke 9:1)

In 1971 when we started our traveling ministry, God impressed on me to bind the evil spirits that would try to hinder our traveling and meetings.

THIS IS the prayer He taught me:

In Jesus Name, we come against the evil spirits that would try to hinder our journey in any way. We bind them and cast them out from in front of us, in Jesus Name. And in Jesus name we just loose the

ministering angels of God to go before us and prepare the highways
and by ways and the traffic
coming and going and that we might have a safe journey home as well.
In Jesus Name,
Amen

Now I don't remember any sermons about this, it's just something the
Lord impressed upon my spirit.

Now we have been doing this for 37 years and there has been
multitudes of times that God has showed things that would of
happened had we not prayed the way we did.

I'm a firm believer in: "if it works, don't try to fix it."

The scripture says that we are to tell the things we have heard, the
things we have seen and the things we know in our heart, in other
words the things that the Holy Spirit has shown us. (2 Peter 3:3 and
Joshua 23: 14)

The reference to Daniel was given as to why we don't loose the
ministering angels. First of all I see no connection, secondly, this was
before the time of Christ, the power and authority and redemption to
the father through his shed blood was not yet

**Daniel 10:12-13 Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first
day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself
before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words. But
the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days:
but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I
remained there with the kings of Persia.**

Christ was one with the father and we are supposed to be, but it
won't happen because we are to earthy, in other words we put the
things of God on hold because of things and circumstances. We have

all at one time or another put spouse or circumstances ahead of what the Spirit wanted us to do.

John 17:11 And now I am no more **in the world**, but these are **in the world**, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.

Hebrews 11:6 But **without faith it is impossible to please him**: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Education in it's self is the total opposite of faith, why? because education says to question everything. But we question things by the way we think or see things by our upbringing or by what man our denomination teaches and not what God teaches.

Matthew 15:2 Why do thy disciples **transgress the tradition** of the elders? for they **wash not their hands** when they eat bread.

The scriptures tell us to compare things with spiritual,

1Corinthians 2:13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, **but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.**

Isaiah 55: 8-9 **For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.**

Why do we try to out guess God? If the scripture says you shouldn't do something then that's the answer sometimes it takes a lot of soul and scripture searching. And all we end up with is what the Holy spirit is trying to tell us.

Over the years I have ask the Lord to search out my soul and spirit and if I am doing something wrong or against his word, to correct me. Now this is something I do frequently for I do not despise the chastening of the Lord. I am not talking about asking the Lord to

search us. Not like we say to someone else, come on in and make yourself at home. If they did, and started opening your dresser drawers etc; you'd soon tell them where to go.

In other words, search me Lord as long as it don't make me uncomfortable or make me eat my words !!

There are many church goers that do not believe in boldness.
Hebrews 13:6 So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

There are many more scriptures on boldness.
