Walk in boldness

The Key or the main ingredient to being bold in the Lord is: being filled with the Holy Ghost and power, or as we call it, Baptized in the Holy Ghost.

Acts 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

We ask the Lord to give us boldness and to bring HIS word to our remembrance as we need it.

Acts 4:29 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, Acts 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

When we read and study his word we have confidence that his word is true and he has given us power and authority to tread on serpents (the devil)

cast out devils and heal the sick.

<u>2Corinthians 7:4</u> Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation.

Ephesians 3:12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.

Philippians 1:20 According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness,

as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death.

1Timothy 3:13 For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 10:19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

1John 4:17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

<u>Hebrews 4:16</u> Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

He Dwells in the Praises of His People:

If you feel you aren't bold in your walk with Christ, you probably spend very little time in praise and worship. His word says:

John 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

A river has an inlet or beginning AND an outlet.

God or the Holy Spirit is the inlet and this is made possible by praising him. As we sing and praise him, He fills us with his presence and anointing (being recharged) and this is a mighty presence and POWER of God, and Will flow out with boldness and power.

BUT, if we only sing a couple of songs once a week, THEN our inlet is cut down to a trickle.

A trickle does not have much power nor boldness. Thus your living water becomes stagnate, a breeding place for parasites.

Psalms 47:6 Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises.

<u>Psalms 22:3</u> But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel. (His people - this includes us)

Most churches are bound by their traditions and time limits. It's pretty hard to get charged up in a few minutes, but if one really enters into a time of worship and praise, (the key word is time) you know in your spirit if your being charged up. Now you have the other fellowships that will spend an hour singing the same choruses and songs over and over trying to prime the Holy Spirit to come upon them.

Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.

True worship and praise comes from the heart, The more you praise God, the more his presence is in you, and you can't help but be bold.

Unfortunately, in our free North American society the head of the household does not want to show their emotions, you cannot praise and worship Christ without your emotion' LOVE IS AN EMOTION at times.

If you don't believe me, just try spending some TIME in praise and worship. Whether it be in your private prayer closet or your gathering with friends in a bible study and especially a prayer meeting.
